- Conditions:
  - Enrolled Suquamish Tribal Members will be given 1<sup>st</sup> priority
  - Tribal Canoe Families will be given 2<sup>nd</sup> priority
  - From recognized Federally enrolled and First Nations Indians will be given 3<sup>rd</sup> priority
  - All applications must be completed, signed and all attachments included
  - All fees must be in full before a space is reserved
  - Payments will be accepted by cash, check or money order, no credit cards accepted
  - By signing this application, applicant agrees to abide by all rules, regulations and codes established by the Suquamish Tribal Canoe Journey Committee, the Suquamish Tribe and other applicable entities.
- Food handling requirements
  - Food Handlers permit is required.
    - Current IHS or County food handlers permit is required for **all** operators and helpers
    - Food Handlers Permit(s) will be displayed at all times of operation
  - Indian Health Service (IHS) Inspection
    - An inspection must be completed BEFORE any food is served to customers
    - All spaces will be subject to an IHS inspections any time during the event
    - Failure to cooperate with inspections and respond to violations will result in immediate forfeiture of space and all fees paid
    - Attached is the IHS "Temporary Food Stand Operators" Hand out
      - All conditions must be met
- Vendor Spaces
  - Address - no vending will be allowed downtown at anytime
    - 18490 Suquamish Way
    - Suquamish WA 98392
  - Fees
    - No application will be considered complete without full payment
    - Cancellation after July 25<sup>th</sup> will result in loss of all fees paid
    - Space fee is \$350.00
  - Dates & Times
    - Set-up starts on Monday, August 3, 2009 at 10:00 am (any attempt to set up prior will result in forfeiture of space and all fees paid)
    - Times
      - Opening time is no earlier than 6:00 am
      - Closing time is no later than 12:00 am
    - Teardown will be completed by Sunday, August 9, 2009 at 12:00 pm (anything left after that period will be confiscated)

- Space size (Pick one)

  - \_\_\_\_\_corner or multi-sided spaces - 10'x10 space with more than one sales side

  - No vehicles' and/or trailers will be allowed in space.
- Amenities
  - No electricity, running water or lights will be provided (any attempt to connect to tribal facilities will result in forfeiture of space and all fees paid)
  - Applicants will provide all tents, canopies, tables, chairs, skirting, etc.
- Security
  - The Suquamish Tribe nor the Suquamish Tribal Canoe Journey Committee is not responsible for any lost, stolen, or damages
  - Suquamish Tribal Public Safety Department is located in the same location of the vendors and will be present during this event.
- Limit of Liability
  - I hereby agree to the terms of this Suquamish Tribal Canoe Journey 2009 Food Vendor Application
  - There is absolutely, no combination General/Food Vendors Spaces
  - I agree to assume all responsibility for my activities as a vendor and agree that I have no claim against the Suquamish Tribe, for injury, damages to, and/or lost or stolen property. I further agree to hold the Suquamish Tribe, its officers, employees, harmless from all suits, claims, or liabilities of any nature on account of injuries or damages sustained by any person or property resulting in whole or in part from any activities as a Vendor under this applications/permit.
